The Palliative Care Choices program provides care and support for Bupa patients when and where you need it.

A range of multidisciplinary clinicians, including specialised carers, are available to provide home-based support to support to you and your family and/or carers.

Services provided to patients are based on ongoing assessment of individual need and preference, including medical, nursing, psychosocial support, respite, personal care and allied health support.

The primary goal of the program is to provide a holistic personal experience tailored to your individual needs and provided in the comfort of your own home.

Bupa is funding HammondCare to provide this program to Bupa members who reside in the Northern Sydney Local Health District, hold an eligible Bupa hospital insurance policy, and meet eligibility requirements.
