

Greenwich Hospital Update - December 2025



As we move quickly toward the holiday season, we wanted to share a short wrap-up of the year—what's been achieved, what's underway, and what's ahead for the redevelopment of HammondCare Greenwich. It has been a significant year of progress, and we're grateful for your patience and support along the way.

A look back at 2025

This year marked major milestones for Stage 1 of the redevelopment, with essential infrastructure upgrades and enabling works progressing smoothly. Four of the six substages of early works have now been delivered. The nursery area and landscaping works have been completed and handed over, and electrical and Sydney Water works are on track for completion in early 2026. These achievements reflect a strong year of preparation as we move toward the next phase of construction.

Refining the design

In our last newsletter, we shared that HammondCare submitted proposed modifications to the NSW Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure. These modifications are now available for review on the Major Projects Hub on the NSW Planning Portal. These refinements remain within the approved building envelope but allow us to consolidate building stages, shorten the overall construction program, and reduce disruption for neighbours.

This adjusted approach will support a smoother transition into the main construction phase and ensure we can deliver services to the community sooner.



What's happening over summer

Contractors will pause work over the Christmas break on 22 December with work resuming on 5 January. When work recommences, Stage 1 enabling activities will continue into early 2026, including the final Sydney Water upgrades and ongoing installation of electrical infrastructure.

Looking ahead to 2026

Next year marks a major turning point for the project. Construction of the new HammondCare Greenwich health campus is expected to begin following completion of Stage 1. Ahead of this, all existing hospital services will temporarily relocate to nearby, fit-for-purpose locations to ensure continuity of care for patients, families and care teams. We will share the details of these temporary service locations early next year.

This redevelopment is a once-in-a-generation investment in care for our community. Through integrated care on site, older people in Northern Sydney will receive the care they need wherever they are. It will be a Centre of Excellence for complex care, research and innovation.

We also want to acknowledge your patience and understanding throughout the year.

We remain committed to transparency and to keeping neighbours, patients, families, and team members connected throughout the life of the project.
