

Greenwich Hospital Update - March 2026

Dear neighbours

We're writing to let you know that the Greenwich Hospital Redevelopment is progressing into the next stage of construction, with works commencing on site from 3 March 2026.

What you'll notice on site

The initial phase of works will focus on site mobilisation. This includes the installation of fencing and hoarding in preparation for the next stage of redevelopment, along with approved tree and shrub removal and other early works. You may notice increased activity on site as this work gets underway.

Initial site mobilisation works will not impact current services offered on site. Services will begin transitioning off the Greenwich campus from 23 March 2026.

New service locations

As we prepare for the next stage of redevelopment, and to ensure we continue delivering care services to the Northern Sydney community, services will relocate as follows:

- In-patient palliative care will move to Neringah Hospital
- Older persons' mental health services will relocate to Riverglen, Macquarie Hospital
- Ambulatory, bereavement, pain telehealth, community palliative care and restorative care will move to the Pacific Centre in St Leonards



Local traffic and access changes

Some temporary changes to local traffic conditions will be in place during this stage of works:

- River Road will have statutory construction signage installed, including reduced speed limits during work hours.
- St Vincents Road will have adjusted daytime parking restrictions to help manage construction vehicle movements.
- The existing St Vincents driveway will be used for approved construction access during this stage.

We understand that some residents currently park within the existing facility grounds. We kindly ask that all vehicles be removed prior to the 3rd of March .

Construction hours

Construction hours will be:

- 7:30am – 5:30pm, Monday to Friday
- 8:00am – 1:00pm, Saturdays

Following the initial site mobilisation works, construction will continue on site to deliver the new Greenwich Redevelopment.
