What is the Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP)?

CHSP is a government subsidised programme that supports older people who are still managing well at home, but need an extra helping hand with everyday tasks that require low-level support. There are a number of services available through CHSP designed to help make life easier, including Flexible Respite.

Any older person who is experiencing difficulty managing at home may be eligible for the Commonwealth Home Support Programme.

Flexible Respite

When you are a carer, it's important to set some time aside for yourself – to catch up with friends, maintain hobbies and take care of the daily tasks.

Flexible Respite can provide regular weekly breaks during the day or overnight, with care delivered in the home or in the community for your family member or friend. Care workers can step in to take care of day to day duties, such as personal care, meal preparation and domestic assistance.

How can I access this service?

CHSP is accessed through My Aged Care, the access and information hub for all Australian Government Aged Care Services.
